

Creating a "MyWisconsin ID" from <https://apps-dev.wisconsin.gov/>

- 1) Go to self-registration link <https://apps-dev.wisconsin.gov/> and click on Sign up.

Enter First name, Last name, Email and click on Sign up.

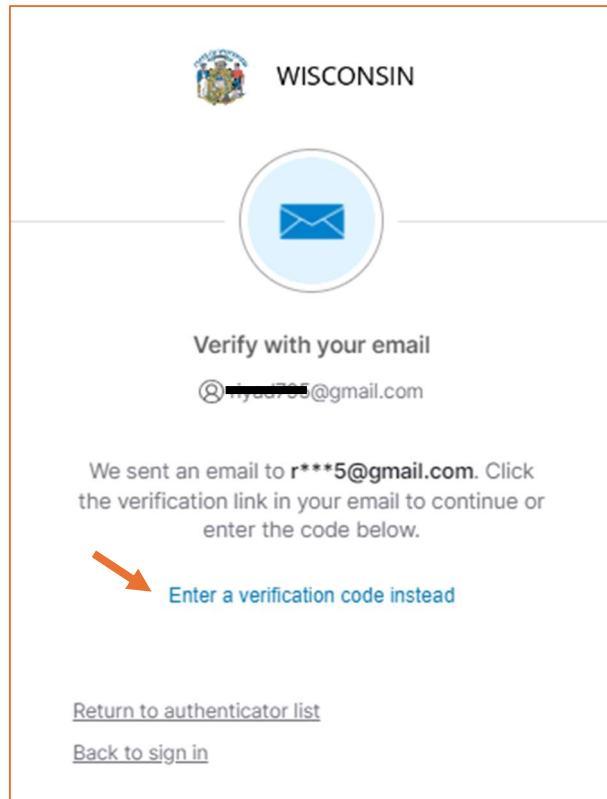

- 5) This will create your “MyWisconsin ID”, but it will NOT grant you access to the SharePoint site. Once you successfully create your “MyWisconsin ID” you need to contact the SharePoint administrator/owner of the site you need access to. Since there are a variety of websites using SharePoint, you will need to know who the administrator/owner for the specific site is that you are requesting access to (likely you already have been in contact with them).
